

St. Haralambos Church is providing food and gifts for 10 Peoria families in need. All items will be picked up by City of Peoria staff on Monday, Dec. 17. It is a program we have been assisting for more than 20 years.

How did we get started?

For those who remember our previous location in Old Town Peoria, we were right across the street from the Peoria Community Center. City of Peoria staff sent a letter asking for help for needy families during the holidays. In those days, once the food and gifts had been wrapped and boxed up, all we had to do was put them on a cart and walk them across the street!

When we moved to our current location, we assured the city staff that we would continue assisting with this program, but they would need to send a truck to pick up our donations. And this is what has been happening each year since.
